Growth Mindset - Ways to Help Your Child

- Talk About It Talk with your child about his/her day, but guide the discussion by asking questions like:
 - Did you make a mistake today? What did you learn from it?
 - What did you do that was difficult today?
- **Praise the Process** Instead of saying, "You're so smart!", praise effort, goal setting, persistence through challenges, or being creative. You can say something like:
 - Wow! You must have worked really hard on this."
- Encourage Failure (say What?!) Your child needs to know that failure can (and often does) happen and it is okay! Do not step in to prevent your child's failure this is how he/she learns to persevere in the face of challenges.
- The Brain Can Grow! Remind your child that his/her intelligence is not fixed. Remind him/her that when things are difficult, his/her brain grows if he/she persists through the challenge. Each time a new skill is learned, the brain is making new connections. Your child needs to know and hear that this is possible.
- Help Your Child Change Dialogue The way your child talks to himself/herself makes a huge impact on mindset. If your child says "This is too hard!", help him/her change that to "I cannot do this yet, but I will keep trying." Give your child the words to say when feeling defeated by modeling this skill yourself.
